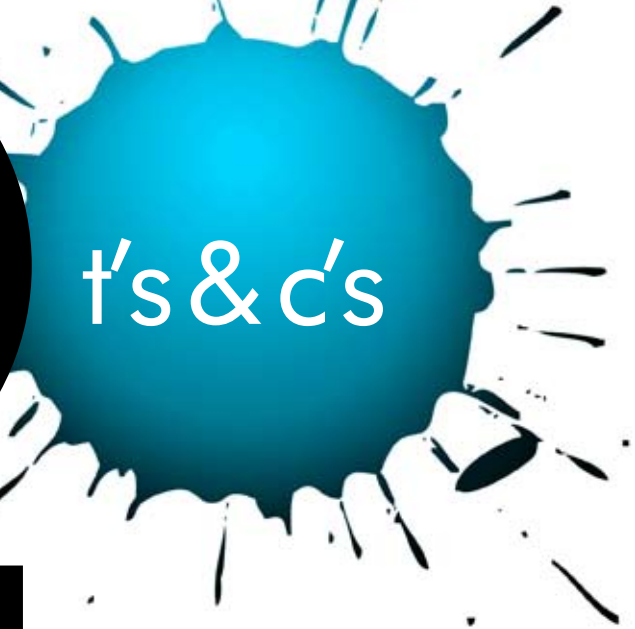
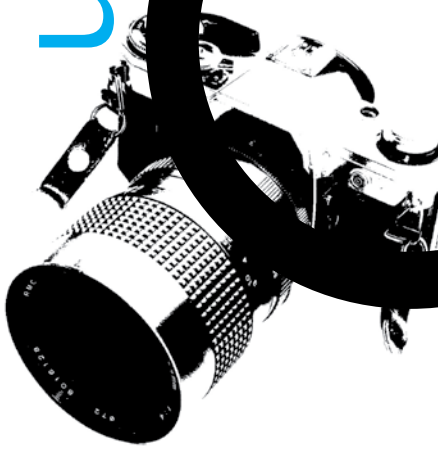

### Terms & Conditions

The organiser is HARMAN technology Ltd, Ilford Way, Mobberley, Cheshire, WA16 7JL

Entry is open to all students aged 16 or over undertaking full or part-time professional photography training at a UK-based college or university. The competition is not open to employees of HARMAN technology, their families and relatives or anyone else connected with the competition.

All images must be printed on HARMAN CRYSTALJET RC inkjet paper and either A4 or A3 in size and submitted under the category of 'INTERACTION' or 'TODAY'.

The closing date for this competition is 31st July 2009. Entries must arrive before or on that date. HARMAN technology accepts no responsibility for any entries that are incomplete, illegible, or fail to reach the address given by the closing date. Proof of posting is not proof of receipt. Winners will be notified by the end of September 2009.

Entries should be sent to: Jane Crossen, Competition Co-ordinator, HARMAN technology Ltd, Ilford Way, Mobberley, Cheshire, WA16 7JL. There is no limit to the number of entries and entries may be made into both categories.

Images which have won any other competition or which have been published by a third party are not eligible for this competition.

All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must have sole ownership of copyright for all images entered and must have obtained the permission of any person or people featured in the image (a model release form must be obtained where appropriate), or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs. It is the legal responsibility of the entrant to ensure that they are compliant with ownership and copyright requirements. Entries which, at any time during the competition process, are found not to fulfil these requirements, will be deemed ineligible and disqualified. If this is discovered after the prize has been awarded the full value of the prize must be returned or refunded by the entrant.

Any images deemed to be offensive will automatically be disqualified.

The college submitting the most entries will win the prize of £750 worth of HARMAN CRYSTALJET RC paper. The winning college must nominate one tutor/lecturer as point of contact with regard to the competition and that person will be responsible for ordering the chosen products from HARMAN technology Ltd. How those products are chosen is the responsibility of the college.

HARMAN technology reserves the right to free reproduction and exhibition of any entered images in all media worldwide in connection with the competition to include: catalogues, posters, leaflets, exhibitions, advertising, packaging and the internet (including the HARMAN technology Ltd website). There will be no further payment to the photographer, model or third party in respect of the winning images.

The winners agree to their names and the winning photographs being published in relation to the competition.

All prints must be labelled on the reverse (a downloadable Image Entry Label is available at [www.harman-inkjet.com/studentcomp09](http://www.harman-inkjet.com/studentcomp09)) and be captioned and carry the entrant's name, the course and college which the student is attending, a point of contact; telephone number or email address. Any print with information on the front will be automatically disqualified as entries are judged anonymously. There will be no exception to this rule.

Prizes are not transferable and there is no cash equivalent.

If the quality of entries falls below the required standard HARMAN technology reserve the right not to award individual prizes. The college prize will be awarded regardless of the amount of entries received and overall quality.

All prints are submitted at the photographer's own risk. The organisers cannot accept liability for any loss of, or damage occurring to, any entries, whether in transit or whilst in the keeping of the organisers, although every care will be taken. To that end, please ensure that entries are sent in secure, adequate and protective packaging.

Prints will be returned only if accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope of an appropriate size and with the correct, standard, first or second-class postage. Prints will be returned as soon as possible after the judging is

complete and winners have been notified. Prize winning entries will be retained until at least March 2010 as it is anticipated that they will be displayed at FOCUS on Imaging in February 2010.

All judges will be appointed by the organisers.

HARMAN technology reserves the right to change the prizes to those of a comparable standard in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

The overall winner is responsible for organising all travel and accommodation arrangements with regard to attending the Digital Printing Workshop. HARMAN technology will contribute £50 towards travel arrangements.

HARMAN technology will not pass on any names, addresses or personal information to a third party not related to the competition.

HARMAN technology reserves the right to cancel the competition at any time, due to unforeseen circumstances.

If, after a reasonable amount of time, any of the winners are not able to be contacted the prize will be awarded to the next best entry.

Entrants should retain the original digital file for reference as it may be required to prove that any image submitted is their own work and to produce extra prints of the entry if required. If this is unavailable when requested the entrant will forfeit any prize agreed beforehand.

Within all categories the judges' decision is final and absolute. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the judges' decision.

By entering this competition each entrant and college will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and HARMAN technology Ltd reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time and at its absolute discretion if it has reason to believe there has been an infringement of these rules.
